

2026 CSA MEMBER AGREEMENT

PLEASE READ THIS AGREEMENT IN FULL AND AGREE TO ALL TERMS BEFORE PROCEEDING.

Organic Farming Awareness & Shared Risk

By participating in the CSA program, you acknowledge that you have reviewed the CSA information provided by Oregon Road Organics and understand the inherent risks involved in farming. These risks include, but are not limited to, weather conditions, pests, and plant diseases. By joining the CSA, you agree to share these risks with Oregon Road Organics as part of your membership.

Program Duration and Share Contents

Your CSA membership guarantees you a **weekly share of organic vegetables** from Oregon Road Organics for **20 weeks or 12 weeks**, depending on the option you selected. In the event that extreme weather or other unforeseen circumstances affect production, the delivery schedule may be adjusted. If shortages occur, Oregon Road Organics may supplement shares with locally sourced and/or organic fruits and vegetables when available.

Pickup Times and Donation Policy

Members are responsible for picking up their CSA share at their designated location on the assigned day and time, as outlined on the Oregon Road Organics website. Shares that are not picked up, and for which no prior arrangements have been made, may be donated to a local food pantry. Missed pickups are not refundable.

CSA Basket Policy & Sustainability Commitment

CSA shares are distributed in **reusable baskets** as part of Oregon Road Organics' sustainability initiatives. Each CSA member will receive **two baskets total** during the season. Members will receive a basket during their first pickup week, which must be **returned the following week** and will be **exchanged for a freshly packed basket**.

Returning baskets each week is **essential** to the operation of the CSA and to reducing waste and single-use materials. Members are responsible for bringing their baskets back on time. Failure to return baskets may result in delayed pickup or replacement fees.

Communication and Responsibility

If someone other than the member will be picking up the CSA share, it is the member's responsibility to ensure that person is informed of the CSA guidelines, pickup procedures, and what items to collect.

Non-Refundable & Non-Transferable

All CSA payments are **final, non-refundable, and non-transferable**. This policy is firm. Members are encouraged to carefully review all program details and ask questions prior to committing.
